THE STUDY CURRICULUM

1st Year: 6 courses with exam - 3 compulsory and 3 electives; 2 seminars on specific topic within the project program specialized on leadership and innovation; start of the doctoral dissertation research

2ⁿd Year: doctoral dissertation research; two compulsory colloquial for doctoral proposal preparation and presentation; conference participation and paper (presentation and publishing)

3rd Year: doctoral dissertation research;
presentation of research results;
published paper in a (listed) journal:
leadership, innovation and project management research
article in a journal in any data base (listed);
